Notice to refuse entry into the Cook Islands

1. The Minister of Foreign Affairs and Immigration hereby issues a Notice not to permit Entry into the Cook Islands as per section 9A of the Entry, Residence and Departures Act 1971-72 on the following persons:

Persons intending to travel to the Cook Islands having originated from or transited through any country, with the exception of New Zealand and Cook Islands, 14 days prior to travel, will be denied entry into the Cook Islands.

This Notice is issued on this day 16 March 2020 with expiry date 18 April 2020.
